In response to the Haitian tragedy, CCOM is organizing another meal packaging event with Stop Hunger Now (www.stophungernow.org). The 40,000 meals packaged on Parish Service Day have been delivered to Haiti & are being used to feed about 50,000 displaced earthquake victims outside Port-au-Prince. On Saturday, Mar. 6, we need your help to package another 80,000 meals for Haiti at Saint Saviour's Center. We have invited other area churches to help us reach our goal. So far Church of the Good Shepherd & White Memorial Presbyterian have agreed to join us. We'll sponsor 2 shifts of 80 people each (8:30-10:30a, and 11:00a-1:00p) on Mar. 6.
