Theology-Lite meets tonight

Joan, a highly readable biography of Joan of Arc, is the focus of our discussion led by Marisa Campbell. Author Donald Spoto, professor and theologian, describes Joan's spritual development and her understanding of the role her "voices" were telling her to play. The author states a central idea of his book: "This book deals with... the mystery of Joan of Arc... I offer it within the belief that the world and everything in it belong to God and matters of God. A mystery is not a puzzle, a problem, or something to be...resolved. In the vocabulary of theology, a mystery is an event, action or person pointing to the presence of the hidden but real God, who enters time and space."
